### **President's Report** by President Deb Sloggett

What another busy couple of weeks it has been. We are in the midst of Rotary convention with Rotarians visiting from all around Australia and the world.

I went to the WASH (water and sanitation) summit on Friday and had such a good day. It was long but inspiring. The work that is going on around the world by so many Rotarians gives hope and encouragement. It made me feel so proud about our project in Cambodia. I did go to a session on WASH and healthcare facilities and it left me shuddering at the photos of what I would call filth that my colleagues are forced to work in, in poverty-stricken countries. From a public health perspective communicable disease and infection won't be beaten if there is no access to clean drinkable water and clean usable sanitation facilities.

The day wasn't all about work, it was a time to meet new people. I accompanied Lucy from Houston to the Exhibition Centre and then we had dinner. We ate with 2 other Rotarians from Pittsburgh.

Saturday I was at the House of Friendship all day helping with the Rotaract Club of Siem Reap and their stand. It has been one of the busiest booths. A lot of people have stopped to talk and connect. The posters telling the story of the projects are colourful and informative. People are loving them. Spending time with the Cambodian students is fun and energising. They are working so hard talking to people and being engaging. Sunday's opening ceremony had 15,000 Rotarians fill Rod Laver
